OLD FASHIONED BUTTER CAKE

1/2 cup (1 stick) butter

1 1/4 cups sugar

3 eggs

1 3/4 cups flour

1/4 teaspoon salt

2 teaspoons baking powder

2/3 cup milk

1 teaspoon vanilla

(Yield: Two 8-inch layers)

Preheat oven to 375 degrees

Butter and flour two 8-inch layer pans

Cream butter. Add sugar, mix well. Add eggs one at a time, beating well after each addition. Sift flour with salt and baking powder; add alternately with the milk. Add vanilla. Pour into prepared pans. Bake for 25-30 minutes. When done, remove from cake pans and cool on wire cake racks. Frost with your favorite icing or try the following recipe for Butter Icing.

OLD FASHIONED BUTTER ICING

1/2 cup milk

2 1/2 tablespoons flour 1/2 cup butter (1 stick)

1/4 teaspoon salt

1/2 cup sugar

1/2 teaspoon flavoring of your choice

(maple, lemon, peppermint)

Boil milk and flour together until thick. Cool. Cream the butter, salt, sugar and flavorings. Add cooled flour and milk mixture and beat at moderate speed until soft and creamy. Makes enough for two layers.

85° with compressed yeast)

1/4 cup soft shortening

1/2 cup sugar

In mixing bowl, dissolve yeast in water. Add sugar, salt and about half the flour. Beat thoroughly 2 minutes. Add egg and shortening. Gradually beat in remaining flour until smooth. Cover with damp cloth; place in refrigerator. Punch down occasionally as dough rises in refrigerator. About 2 hr. before baking, cut off amount needed and return remaining dough to refrigerator. Shape into rolls and place on greased baking sheet. Cover. Let rise until light (1 1/2 to 2 hr.). Heat oven to 400 degrees. Bake 12 to 15 minutes. Makes 4 dozen medium rolls.

Keep warm and let raise again. Bake in 425 degree oven for 30 minutes


