Modern lighting equipment makes evening bathing a pleasure and the large space for parking provides ample room for all.

Crestwood Lake is operated on a membership plan with certain protective restrictions to limit the membership to desirable people.

The membership plan makes it possible for the thrifty family to enjoy a season's pleasure most economically.
