Taxes will be received at my store at Allendale, each week day. No taxes received on the 20th day of December.

Taxes that are not paid by December 20th will be returned to a Justice of the Peace on that day, according to law, and 12 per cent. interest and all costs will be added until paid.

All unpaid taxes on Real Estate will be returned to the County Clerk as a first lien on the property assessed, on or before the first day of February, 1901, when all costs, fees and interest will be added to the tax.
