

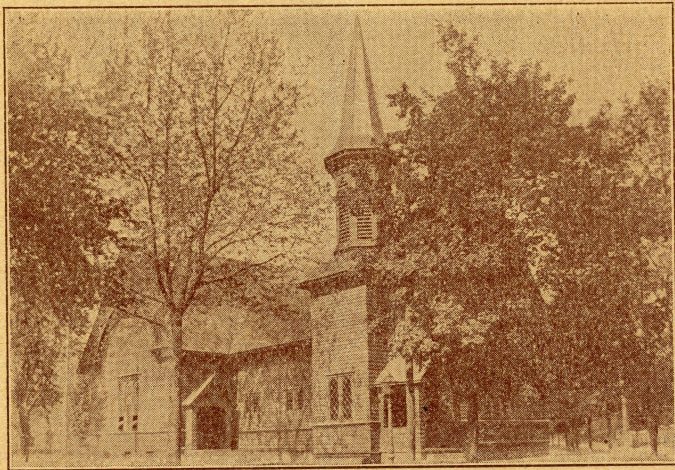

Fifty years ago, the corner stone of the Archer Memorial Methodist Episcopal Church was laid by the Rev. J. L. G. McKown, D. D. of Jersey City. The building was the gift of Mr. O. H. P. Archer in memory of his father, Mr. Jonathan Archer. Addresses were delivered by Rev. Drs. W. P. Abbott, T. Lodge and J. L. G. McKown. Rev. R. B. Collins, pastor of the New Prospect Church, read a list of the contents of the box placed in the stone.

The following Sunday, the building was dedicated by Bishop Janes assisted by Dr. Abbott.

The original structure was enlarged and improved twice. The picture on the front of this program shows the building as it now appears.

The Moller organ was dedicated Nov. 11th, 1923.

From 1876 to 1886, the activities were carried on under the direction of the New Prospect, now Waldwick, Church. Since then, Allendale has been a separate appointment.
