

Dr. Harry Archer Invited To Speak

Surgeon Will Address Corps At Dedication Of Ambulance *AC-2*

An address by Dr. Harry Archer who was active in the founding of the Allendale Fire Department, will be the feature of dedication services Sunday at 2:30 p. m. of the new ambulance of the Allendale Ambulance Corps.

A program for the dedication was planned Sunday morning at a committee meeting at the home of Captain Paul D. O'Connor, dedication chairman. The event will take place at Recreation Park, and a short parade will follow the ceremonies.

An American flag donated by the New York Carnival supply house with whom the Corps deals will be presented by Former Councilman John P. Doehling, who was instrumental in forming the corps. He will also present a Corps service banner, his own gift to the group. Harold R. Greene of Ramsey, first aid instructor for Ramapo Valley Chapter, American Red Cross, will be master of ceremonies.

President Carl Wehner will receive the banners for the Corps. Keys for the new ambulance will be presented to O'Connor by H. L. Wagner, representing the manufacturer, after which it will be christened. After a few words by Mayor Louis A. Keidel, Dr. Archer will be introduced.

Music for the parade will be provided by the Waldwick Sons of the Legion Drum and Bugle Corps, after which the marchers will go to the firehouse for refreshments.
