

Firemen Will Have Anniversary Fete

William Dewsnap, Pres- ident 25 Years, to Be Feted

Allendale firemen will hold a 25th anniversary dinner to honor William Dewsnap, who retires this month after heading the department as president for that length of time.

John Appert was elected Friday night to succeed Dewsnap, who declined to run for re-election. In several past years both he and veteran Vice-President Albert I. Zabriskie have expressed wishes to step down, but they have been re-elected over their protests. This year they were insistent.

Zabriskie is succeeded by Kenneth Booth. Chief George Megnin was re-elected, as was Assistant Chief Jacob Kaplan. Charles Bijou is captain; and Edwin Grossman, lieutenant. Trustees are Edwin Grosman, David Garrabrant and Booth. George Gasparini is a representative for three years.

The dinner for Dewsnap will be January 20. The place will be announced. Appert will take charge of arrangements.
