

Two New Marshals For Allendale

Appointments Made At Council Meeting

Allendale Borough Council meeting Thursday evening approved the appointments of Werner Baarck of Dale Avenue and Kenneth M. Booth of West Maple Street as new marshals. Baarck is the building superintendent and Booth is president of the Allendale Fire Department.

John Lothian, chairman of the finance committee, reported that after paying off all bills presented at the meeting, there is a bank balance for the Borough of \$20,190.49. Lothian also submitted the report of David M. Colburn, tax collector which listed all outstanding taxes as of March 1, 1943.

Chairman Carl Wehner, of the water committee, announced that water service had been discontinued for four delinquent residents, who had promptly paid up the bill and the service charge for turning on the meter. He urged all residents to co-operate promptly in paying water bills.
