

# Family Quarrel Leads to Arrest

Alexander Nestor of Paterson was arrested in Paterson late Sunday night by Allendale Police Chief Kenneth Booth on assault charges preferred by his estranged wife in Allendale earlier in the evening.

The couple, Chief Booth reported yesterday, had been separated three weeks. Mrs. Nestor had been staying with a sister in Mahwah. Sunday afternoon Mr. Nestor telephoned to see if a reconciliation could be effected. They were riding.

The car developed a flat tire in Allendale. A dispute arose, "something to do with the alleged ownership of the car," said the Allendale Police chief. Mrs. Nestor claims her husband choked her, the Chief said.

Mrs. Nestor went to the local state police who referred her to Allendale authorities. She signed a complaint before Allendale Recorder J. Frank Rouault, and had a warrant issued. Chief Booth and Police Marshal Fred Bavelaar scoured Allendale without success. Mrs. Nestor gave the Allendale policemen the address of Mr. Nestor's mother in Paterson.

The Allendale officers went to Paterson police authorities who assigned a local detective to help them continue their quest. Mr. Nestor was found at midnight, arrested and taken to Hackensack.
