Careless Drivers Pay \$10 Penalties

Frank W. Lambert, 19, of Ackerman Rd., Allendale, and Martin W. Antonick, 21, of 158 West Crescent Ave., Ramsey, were both found guilty of a careless driving charge and each paid a fine of \$7.50 and \$2.50 court costs in Allendale police court last night before Recorder J. Frank Roubault. Their cars were involved in a collision on Franklin Turnpike at 7 p. m. on April 14. State Trooper A. V. Pepe of the Ramsey Barracks investigated and issued the summonses.

Louis Marino, of Paterson, charged with speeding at 50 miles per hour on Franklin turnpike, failed to appear in court and a warrant was issued for his arrest.

The following residents paid fines of \$1 and \$2 costs of court for not securing dog licenses: Fred Magro, Marie Henderson, Bligh Parker, Charles Beaver and Mrs. Clark Parkhurst. Recorder Roubault explained that dog licenses should be taken out each year during the month of January, with deadline Jan. 31. Written notices were mailed to all violators, giving them until noon last Saturday, to secure their dog tags and those not taking advantage of this final notice were issued summonses by Police Chief Kenneth Booth.

T. Hattrich was found not guilty and the complaint dismissed, as his dog is only five months old. A dog must be licensed when it becomes seven months of age or when it has a full set of teeth.
