



HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PAST

- 1785-90 Methodists began to hold meetings in the groves or camp meetings.
- 1797 Records of New Prospect, now Waldwick Church, begin. This is the Mother Church of the area. Its first minister and associates served a circuit stretching from Belleville, N. J. to Haverstraw, New York.
- 1876 Feb. 17th, 3 P.M., Archer Chapel, now part of the Church building, was opened for Sunday School purposes. Previously Sunday School classes were held in some homes.
- 1876 June 18th, The Chapel was dedicated for church services. A preacher, who rode a circuit serving other churches, was assigned to hold services regularly in Allendale.
- First full-time preacher, Rev. W. R. George, assigned to Archer Church.
 Records begin to show meetings in Archer Hall.
- 1893 Nov. 5th. Enlarged and beautified Archer Memorial Methodist Episcopal Church re-dedicated. The church was debt-free, a gift of Mr. O. H. P. Archer. Cost was \$18,000.00.

 Present Parsonage built. It was owned by the Archer family who gave it to the church in 1901.
- 1903 Electric lighting installed in Hall.
- 1923 Present Moeller organ dedicated. Rev. C. C. Woodruff was the minister, Mrs. Gilbert E. Nichols, the organist.
- 1926 The Fiftieth Anniversary was celebrated under the leadership of Rev. J. C. Hofer.




The Scouts have their own meeting room in the War Memorial Building and meet once a week on Monday evenings.
