

Lt. F. A. Parenti Is Given Badge Of New Rank

ALLENDALE — Police Sgt. Frank A. Parenti Jr. was pleasantly surprised at last Thursday's council meeting when he was promoted to the rank of lieutenant.

Council President Victor J. Cotz, acting mayor in the absence of Mayor George A. Dean, appointed the new lieutenant. Presenting the officer with his new badge, Councilman Robert I. Newman, police committee chairman, said "We are quite fortunate to have such a man in our police department."
