Rouault Becomes Allendale's 1st Full Time Borough Clerk

ALLENDALE -- For the first time in its 70 year history, this borough is employing a full time clerk. Due to a steadily increasing work load, J. Frank Rouault, who has been its part time clerk for seven years, has assumed full time duties, with an office in the Municipal Building.

The clerical work of the

borough was previously handled during evening and weekend hours by an employee who depended upon another job for his primary support. However, with the growth of population and the resulting expansion of municipal business, the Borough Council recently decided not only to employ a full time clerk, but to make room for him in the Municipal Building.

As a result, officials are wondering how they might expand office space in the building which was thought by a good segment of the population to be a somewhat extravagant purchase a few short years ago.

Mr. Rouault has been a resident of Allendale for 29 years. He and Mrs. Roualt are the parents of two sons, Richard, a member of the Board of Health in Ramsey, and James, an employee of the Telephone Co.

Borough business will now be conducted from 9 to 4 p.m. just inside the main door of the building.
