


#### SWIMMING PROGRAM

Persons who register for swimming will become members of the "Crestwood Swim Club" and will be permitted to bathe in the lake and use its facilities. Two swimming areas will be available, one shallow with a gently-sloped bottom and the other with greater depth for the more advanced swimmers and for the divers.

Swimming lessons will be provided at specific times during the season. The instruction will cover the full range of proficiency, begginer classes to Red Cross Life Saving. Information on schedules will be forthcoming soon.

The lake in Crestwood Park is artificial, and as such, has a clean sandy bottom. The water is chlorinated by a dual system and is maintained in adherence with health codes. Every effort is made to assure the highest level of water quality and safety.

#### **MEMBERSHIP**

Use of the lake will be limited to members of the Crestwood Swim Club and their guests. The number of guests admitted will be limited and will be indicated in the Swim Club's "Rules & Regulations." Any Allendale resident may join the club.

Everyone is urged to register as soon as possible and take advantage of the low pre-season rates. Please include full payment with your registration, which can be mailed or brought to the Borough Hall.

Some call it the "summer day camp." That term defines Allendale's summer recreation program very well. In a period usually six weeks long, our younger citizens of age 6 to 12 and their guests can enjoy a full program that includes games, crafts, occasional visits to points of interest in the area, in addition to projects limited only by the imaginations and energies of our competent counselors.

Registration for this program will be conducted at the Crestwood Swim Club gatehouse starting May 27 (first day of the swimming season) and at times posted thereafter. Children from families registered with the Swim Club pay no fee; others will be charged \$5.00. There will be a nominal fee charged all registrants for supplies and craft materials.

Activities will usually center around the Red Barn Pavilion, which offers grassy play areas, shelter from rain and sun, and good restrooms. Nearby are wooded areas suitable for hikes or nature study, and, of course, our ball fields are not far away.

#### FUTURE PLANS

If you have tramped the length and breadth of Crestwood Park, you'll appreciate its immense potential. Out of the dozens of possibilities, here are five that have been suggested to the Recreation Committee. Some may be implemented this year. Depending on your support, others may be undertaken in the future.

Competitive swimming. This would permit the best mermaids and mermen in Allendale to compete with those from other towns in the area.

Canoe instruction. This will necessitate the purchase of craft (we now have only rowboats). They will be a welcome addition to our water-based recreation programs.

Boat dock. This structure could be used for both competition swimming and boating.

Toddler park. This will be located near the shallow-water beach area (where families and younger children are expected to gather.) The park will be surrounded by a fence, and will contain play-yard apparatus and benches.

<u>Ice skating</u>. There is strong interest in the construction of a "rink" large enough to provide wintertime enjoyment for all age groups.
