Dear Dominick,

The preliminary plans presented by Kinsey and Associates to the borough offer a wonderful vision of our athletic fields.

The Allendale Recreation Commission would like to assist the borough in making this vision a reality as soon as possible. The initial plans, as proposed by Kinsey and Associates, show that fields 3 and 4 will remain located in their approximate current positions and will continue to be used as baseball and softball fields.

These fields are currently utilized by grades 1-4 where we have greater participation than at any other level. The Allendale Recreation Commission would like to donate \$8,500.00 to the borough to be utilized to renovate field 4 prior to the end of April 1992.

This donation would allow the borough to begin implementation of Kinsey and Associates preliminary recommendations and provide for improved safety and playing conditions for the 1992 playing season.

Specifically, we would like you to use this donation to improve field 4 as follows:

- 1) A slight shift of the field on the first base side to remove play from a back yard area and to open this area further by removal of shrubs and other growth.
- The replacement of the backstop and fence with a new location approximately 6 feet back from the present backstop position.
- 3) The correction of the third base drainage problem via a retaining wall (or a more practical and cost effective recommendation by Kinsey Associates).
- 4) The installation of an outfield fence to reduce injury and avoid problems with poison ivy.

Additionally, based upon the success of our fund raising in the spring, we would like to make a similar donation for the completion of field 3 in September 1992.

We are off to a great start toward improving our athletic facilities! Working together, we look forward to wonderful results in 1992 and beyond. We look forward to your positive response to our donation.
