

SOCIETY NEWS

In April's issue of Allendale History and Heritage, in the ongoing series on "Allendale Houses Built Before 1940," there appeared a brief summary about the house at 90 East Orchard St. We should have mentioned in this summary that Leslie Johnson, who lived in the house for more than a decade, from 1945-1956, was Mayor of Allendale in 1951 and 1952. Bayard Webster, present owner of the house, called to add the information that he has owned the house since 1957, and a back porch and tandem garage have been added.

Society member Claire Tholl wrote in September to tell us that she had been invited into the home of the Hildebrandts at 450 Brookside Avenue [Rossner House; later Crothers]. She wrote: "It has now been expanded "House & Garden" style but had been through about 3 redos before that....[There is] an early house within. It is



the SW corner extending eastward to include the center hall. There is little left to go by, but I would date it between 1800 and 1830. The ceiling has been removed to expose beams in that section but they were not meant to be seen. It may have been 1-1/2 stories but due to placement of gable end windows (if orig.) was probably 2-1/2 stories and one room deep."

We wrote about this house in the Allendale History and Heritage issue of April 1988: "This

house was built about 1878 or earlier....Louis Rossner and his bride, the former Sarah Viola Smith, moved to this house in 1880, about two years after their marriage in Brooklyn in April 1878. It is possible that a "Captain Smith, an old sea captain" lived in the house about 1874."

It now seems likely that the house existed even before 1874.

ALLENDALE HOUSES BUILT BEFORE 1940

Compiled by Pat Wardell

Compiler's Note: This "inventory" of pre-1940 Allendale houses has been compiled using information in the Society's files and in my own files. Very few of the houses have been systematically researched, so we know that for most of them, the information is incomplete. We would welcome any additions, corrections, updating, etc. from our readers, and will happily add such information to the Society's files.

Only houses still in existence today are included in this inventory. Houses are generally named for the earliest known owner/occupant. Names associated with a house are not necessarily always owners; some may have been tenants. Also, not all owners actually lived in houses they owned; some houses were leased for rental income. The houses are listed alphabetically by street names, then numerically by house number.



25 Elm Street Neufeld House

Block 1808, Lot 9 (Old Block 31, Lot 39)

Built about 1935.

Helen F. Neufeld and William G. Neufeld, 1923-? In 1940 this house was described as a one story, one



family frame dwelling with extension and rear sunroom on a 60 x 212 plot. It had a wood shingle exterior, composition shingle roof, and a concrete block foundation. There were 4 rooms, including 2 bedrooms, partly finished sun room, plus one tile bath. There was a half excavated basement and outbuildings were a garage and shop.

In 1940 this house was described as a one family, one story frame dwelling with a porch and extensions, plus a garage and a shed, on a 60 x 220 average plot. It had a wood shingle exterior, a wood shingle roof, and a concrete foundation. There were six rooms, including three bedrooms, and a tile bath.

37 Elm Street Van Blarcom House

Block 1808, Lot 7 (Old Block 31, Lot 43)

Built at a different site about 1850-1885. (1850 according to Girl Scout's Old House List, but it seems more likely to have been built about 1885.)

This house originally stood on the northeast corner of West Allendale Avenue and Maple Street. It was the home of Stephen J. Van Blarcom. It is not shown on the 1876 Walker's Atlas, but is probably the unlabelled house shown in about its former location on the 1887 Driving Chart.

At its former location, the house was, from June 1924 until February 1927, a headquarters for New Jersey State Police. Miss Ethel Borger, in an interview during the 1970s, recalled that this house had been moved, about 1929? to its present Elm Street location.

Stephen J. Van Blarcom, the son of James S. Van Blarcom and Abigail Ann Van Blarcom, was born at Wyckoff September 2, 1846, and married, December 18, 1867, Eliza Jane Packer. They had two daughters, Anna Van Blarcom, born about 1871 (married George H. Repka), and Jennie (Jemima?) Van Blarcom, born about 1876.

S.J. Van Blarcom was a carpenter and builder, and erected many houses and public buildings in Allendale, including: The Archer Memorial Methodist Church (original building, 1876), the Methodist Parsonage (37 East Allendale Avenue), and the 1896 Allendale School House (today's Allendale Police headquarters at 290 Franklin Turnpike). He died at his West Allendale Avenue home on March 30, 1926.

38 Elm Street Winter-Bohr House

Block 1809, Lot 11 (Old Block 35, Lot 63)

Built about 1915.

John W. Winter, c. 1915-1922. Alfred H. Bohr and Florence K. Bohr, 1920-1933. Florence K. Bohr, 1933-? (prob. after 1955). W. E. Hackett, Jr. (1963-64 Here's Allendale).

The lot was conveyed in two transactions: May 11, 1922 from John W. Winter to Florence K. Bohr, plot 75.39 x 157.66; and May 11, 1922 from Garret H. Winter to Florence K. Bohr, plot 75.39 x 149.97.

In 1940 this house was described as a two story frame dwelling with bays, extensions, and open porches, on a 150 x 132 plot. An outbuilding was a 18'6" x 26'6" barn. The house had a wood shingle exterior, a composition shingle roof, and a stone and brick foundation. There were seven rooms, including four bedrooms, and a wood and plaster bath.


45 Elm Street

Van Blarcom-Watson House

Block 1808, Lot 6 (Old Block 31, Lot 45)

Built about 1905.
