



Services Provided:

The Allendale Police Department patrols the Borough 24 hours per day, and in addition to routine crime prevention, investigation, and enforcement duties, provides first response to all medical, fire, and rescue emergencies. Common service calls answered by patrol officers involve investigation of all motor vehicle accidents, domesticated and wild animal complaints, vacant house checks, assisting disabled and locked out motorists, and assisting residents with burglar alarm and physical security concerns.

School Crossing Guards are posted by the Police Department, and students receive safety lessons and D.A.R.E. instruction taught in Public Schools by patrol staff.

Police headquarters is staffed 24 hours per day, dispatching all Borough emergency services. In-house computer system maintains emergency location and contact information on all residential and business property, and cross-references emergency keys that residents may store at headquarters. Dispatchers phones are equipped to trace phone numbers to addresses and accept calls from the deaf (T.D.D.). A driveway mounted intercom system allows the physically challenged direct access to emergency personnel. A referral sourcebook is maintained by desk staff, connecting those in need with free shelter, counseling, psychiatric screening, and domestic violence relief.

Staff members, by appointment, provide various free services, including home security checks, bicycle registration and safety products, traffic safety/seat belt information, group tours of headquarters, K-9 demonstrations, and public speaking engagements.

EMERGENCY 9-1-1 NETWORK

History

In 1989 the New Jersey Legislature enacted legistlation to establish a statewide 9-1-1 network. As a result of this legislation each county and municipality appointed a 9-1-1 coordinator. It was the job of these coordinators to work with state and county officials as well as the telephone company to develop an implementation plan. We needed to assure that each address within our boundary was properly recorded in the phone company's computer files. This address verification involved comparing phone company records against actual house numbers, and placing this information on a map of the Borough.

In some municipalities, the coordinator had to work with the post office to change addresses due to duplication and other problems.

After almost five years and much hard work 9-1-1 was finally brought to Bergen County on January 12th of this year. After much deliberation Mahwah Police were selected to answer Allendale's 9-1-1 calls.

How It Works

When a 9-1-1 call is made from Allendale, it will be answered by a state certified operator at Mahwah Police headquarters, who will already know where you are calling from. This operator will determine what the emergency is and then transfer the call to Allendale Police, creating a three-way conversation. Once the essential information is passed to the Allendale dispatcher the appropriate units are dispatched. If the call is a request for medical assistance, the operator may stay on the line to provide the caller with instructions on how to help the sick or injured person until police or ambulance personnel arrive.

Imoportant Points

- 1. 9-1-1 works from any telephone. Residential, pay, or cellular phones all support 9-1-1.
- 2. 9-1-1 is a free call. There is no need to put money into a pay phone to call 9-1-1.
- 3. 9-1-1 should be used for any emergency or suspected emergency. If you think that life or property are in danger, or see a crime in progress, call 9-1-1. Do not hesitate because you aren't sure what you see is an emergency. The 9-1-1 operator will determine that. If your call is not an emergency you will be advised and told to call the business number (825-1900).
- 4. If you call 9-1-1 by accident, stay on the line. Tell the operator you dialed 9-1-1 accidentally. A police officer will be sent to your location to verify that all is OK if you hang up the phone. Your address and phone number will be displayed on our computer screen and we must verify all calls or call attempts.

The Allendale Volunteer Fire Department was established in January of 1910 when a group of Allendale citizens, spurred into action by a disastrous fire in 1909, which destroyed the residences housing the Kornhoff Bakery and the Scholz Barber Shop, purchased eleven iron tires from the Erie Railroad. These were hung in frames to serve as Allendale's first fire alarms. In March 1910, a hook and ladder truck was ordered at a cost of \$995.00.



RECYCLING INFORMATION

As of June 1, 1988 the Borough of Allendale has collected for recycling a number of various materials. Glass (clear, green, brown), Aluminum and Bi-Metal Cans, Plastics (#1-PETE & #2-HDPE), and Newspapers from household garbage. These materials are collected curbside by the Department of Public Works with the exception of Newspapers. Newspapers.



pers are collected by the Boy Scouts. At the Compost Site on W. Crescent Avenue, the following recyclable materials are also accepted. Magazines, junkmail, office paper, tires (no large truck tires), household batteries and cardboard are accepted at this location. You can also recycle your glass, cans and plastics at this location if you miss your curbside colection.

The hours of operation for this facility are: Saturdays 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. during January, February and March. During April through December this facility is open Saturdays 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. and Sundays 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.

Since recycling began in 1988 the residents of Allendale have reduced the amount of garbage they throw out. In 1988 there were over 3600 tons of garbage collected. Since then we have seen a reduction of 1400 tons with the amount collected in 1994 at 2200 tons. This is a reduction of 34% through recycling.

The benefits from recycling are many, such as saving natural resources, keeping taxes in check with lower cartage fees, and earning both state and county aid based on the tonnage recycled in Allendale. Recycling fliers with the designated collection dates and other recycling information are available at the Borough Hall.

Crestwood Lake is a municipal facility and includes the lake, three beaches and the Red Barn, a pavilion available, by permit, for group activities. It is also the site of a summer recreation program. Crestwood's facilities are open to all residents of Allendale for a nominal fee. Swimming instruction and a swim team are available in the summer. There are tennis courts adjacent to the Red Barn which are available for use by residents for a modest fee. In addition, in the winter, one area of the property is flooded so that residents can ice-skate, weather permitting.



THE EARLY HISTORY OF ALLENDALE

he approximately three and five eighths square miles that are known today as Allendale, were part of a vast wilderness known only to the native American Indians until the early 1700's, when a few adventurous settlers began to carve out farms and build homesteads in the vicinity. Allendale was then part of the Ramapo Tract, a 42,500 acre parcel of land controlled by the East New Jersey Board of Proprietors. The Proprietors were largely old world real estate speculators, and many of them never set foot on the American land they controlled from afar.

Some of Allendale's earliest settlers included families named Lauback, Van Houten, Vanderbeek, Garrison, Storms, Winter, Wilson, Pulis, Smith, Van Blarcom, Crouter, Ackerman, Powell, Quackenbush, Zabriskie, Christopher, Van Horn and Mallinson.

Until 1767, the Allendale area was part of a "precinct" or a large area with no official local government. When a locality name was used for the area, it usually was linked to a nearby landmark. Thus, John Fell, a well-known Bergen County patriot and member of the Continental Congress, whose home still stands at 475 Franklin Turnpike in Allendale, was said to live in Paramus, or roughly within the jurisdiction of the Paramus Church. During the Revolution, because of his patriotic influence, Fell was taken prisoner at his home by a band of 25 armed Loyalist raiders on April 22, 1777 and confined in the provost jail in New York City for more than a year.

During the first half of the 19th century, our area was known as "The Turnpike," taking its name from the newly chartered toll road running through the settlement - the Franklin Turnpike. It was chartered as a toll road in 1806 and was once part of the Albany Post Road. A toll gate house once stood on the southwest corner of the intersection of Franklin Turnpike and Crescent Avenue (its well house still stands today).

Allendale at this time was a farming community; farmers raised large amounts of fruit, including apples and peaches (hence Orchard Street). But Allendale became most well known for its strawberries, which were shipped in huge quantities to nearby markets in Paterson, Newark and New York by horse drawn wagons at first and later by train.

The railroad came to Allendale in the 1840's with planning, surveying and construction continuing from 1841 until October 1848 when the first train ran through the town. Its route through this area was surveyed by Joseph Warner Allen, an engineer from south Jersey. While working here, he stayed with the Ackerman family in the old Fell house on Franklin Turnpike, and when a name was needed for the depot, his name was incorporated into "Allendale."

With the coming of the railroad, Allendale's first stores opened. Smith Roswell, who came to Allendale as the Erie's first station agent, opened what was probably Allendale's first store about 1850. Later Charlie May and Morris S. Ackerman ran stores in the corner of the hotel.

J. Smith operated a saw mill near Crescent Avenue-Brookside Avenue intersection by 1861, and Henry Mallinson ran a blacksmith and wagon shop at the intersection of Allendale Avenue and Franklin Turnpike by the same date. Later John J. Van Horn ran a blacksmith shop and cider mill on Franklin Turnpike.

Peat was mined in 1866 and 1867 by John J. Zabriskie on the meadows in Allendale once known as Wolf Swamp (an Indian gathering place), later as Appert's farm or the Celery Farm and today as a wildlife refuge. About 1880 Albert Lydecker erected a grist mill on the Ho-Ho-Kus brook near West Crescent Avenue, and Hopper Yeomans ran a traveling butcher shop, carrying meats and vegetables by wagon to customers on his route. R.V. Ackerman ran his general store on Park Avenue near the Erie Depot, and Abraham Rowland opened another general store on Cottage Place. Still another grocery store opened near the center of what is today's business district, and after a series of partnerships and name changes it became known as Winter Brothers' store, later changing from groceries to strictly hardware.

By 1859, the railroad began to bring its first commuters to the area. New Yorkers looking for the healthy country life began to come to Allendale and its neighboring towns. Some came and settled. Some wealthy city people established summer homes here, and others came to vacation, to the extent that Allendale, by the 1880's, was gaining a reputation as the "Newport of Bergen County". It was said that during the 1880's and 1890's, there was barely a house in town that didn't have a "boarders" sign hanging out front. One of the most influential newcomers was Oliver Hazard Perry Archer, a former Erie Railroad vice president, who by 1869 had made Allendale his summer home.

This signalled the beginning of the end of the strawberry frenzy in Allendale. Farmers began to realize that their farmland could bring them more money when sold as building sites than it did when planted with crops. In 1868 Herman Tallman and Harvey Sherwood bought a 34 acre tract from John A. Garrison and his wife, Dolly. They subdivided this tract into building plots and laid out streets including Park Avenue, Mallinson Street and First Street; hence Allendale's first real estate "development" was born. About the same time, Daniel Anthony cleared approximately 100 acres along two streets, Anthony Street (now Brookside Avenue) and Allendale Avenue and created 120 building plots, which he offered for sale at between \$50 and \$100 each.

Allendale's two oldest churches were also established about this time. The Episcopal Church of the Epiphany grew from a Sunday school started in 1872 in the homes of Mrs Stephen Cable and her daughter, Mrs. James Reading. In 1875, O.H.P. Archer built the Archer Memorial Methodist Church.

Telephones came to the area in 1879 when the first exchange opened in Paterson with 11 subscribers. Allendale's first phone, in 1897, was a pay station in R.V. Ackerman's store.

Officially part of New Barbadoes Township since 1693, in 1767 Allendale (and a large surrounding territory) became Franklin Township. In 1849, a large section of Franklin Township, including part of Allendale, became Ho-Ho-Kus Township. In April 1885, this area was divided and part of it, including much of present day Allendale, was called Orvil Township. In 1894, Allendale residents who were outraged that the proposed new school district was to be built in the New Prospect-Waldwick area instead of in Allendale, drew up a petition calling for a public vote to form a separate borough. In November 1894, Allendale residents voted 100 for and 11 against the establishment of a new borough, which was formed from parts of Franklin, Ho-Ho-Kus and Orvil Townships. Two years later, Allendale had its own new schoolhouse (which today is Allendale's Polic Station) at a building cost of \$5,500.

In 1902 the depot, which had stood on the east side of the tracks, was moved to its present location on the west side of the tracks. In December 1903, four tracks, instead of the previous two tracks, were put into operation. By about 1911, the North Jersey Rapid Transit Company was running a trolley through Allendale.

The next two decades brought a new look to what became Allendale's business district - the stretch of West Allendale Avenue just east of the railroad station. What had formerly been a residential section, with streets lined with homes, was changed into a commercial area with stores and storefront buildings. Some of the houses were converted into stores, and others were torn down or moved to nearby streets (High Street and Myrtle Avenue, for instance) to make room for the building of stores. By 1930, the business district looked much the way it does today.
