# Young Farm Helper Is Seriously Injured

## Pearl River Man Falls From Trailer In Saddle River

A possible broken back and badly managled ankles were the result of an accident to Harry Jersey, of Pearl River, an employee on the David Carlough farm in Saddle River yesterday.

Jersey, who is 34 and married, was taken to the Nyack Hospital at 3:40 yesterday by Kenneth Booth, J. Kaplan, Henry Knase and Gus Sonn of the Allendale Ambulance Corps, after a call had been received from Clinton Carlough, who led the way to the hospital in his car.

The accident occurred when Jersey, who had been on his way to his car on the Carlough farm, turned back suddenly and leaped on the side of a trailer laden with ladders which was being towed behind a tractor from one orchard to another. The man's feet were dangling over the side of the trailer, and apparently one of the feet caught in the spokes of a wheel, pulling him underneath the vehicle.

Although Jersey was immediately rushed to the hospital, the exact extent of his injuries could not be determined at once, but the authorities fear his back may be broken and both ankles may have received compound fractures.
