The post office was established in Allendale, N.J. on November 11, 1869.

Post Office Locations

- 1) Erie railroad station. Postmaster at the time served in a dual capacity as both ticket agent & Postmaster.
- 2) Winters General Store. Which was located on the present site of the new postal facility.
- 3) Present location of the Allendale Cleaners, 79 W. Allendale Ave.
- 4) May 30, 1936, located in the present quarters at 100 W. Allendale Ave.
