They lived on Myrtle Avenue, Allendale, Bergen Co., NJ by June 1905 in a house they rented. They may have lived in the house at 61 Myrtle Avenue (built 1877), perhaps until their 56 Myrtle Avenue house was built about 1913.

He was the Erie RR station agent at Allendale from 1902 until 1928. He was also Allendale postmaster for 11 years.

On 29 May 1952 the premises at 56 Myrtle Avenue, previously owned by Michael and Elizabeth McDermott, were conveyed to Mary E. Spicher.

• **Catherine McDermott**, b. Nov 1886 PA; m. **Maurice Lonergan**. In June 1905 she was an assistant postmaster. They lived in Clifton in 1919 and moved into the Beaver house on West Allendale Avenue, Allendale, NJ, in October 1919. She

lived in Suffern, NY in March 1939.

- **Agnes Virginia McDermott**, b. Jan 1888 PA; m. 1915 **Theodore Hornblower Blackmore**. They lived in Allendale.
- **Loretta McDermott**, b. Sept 1889 NY; m. after Jan 1920 -?- **Driscoll**.
- **Mary Elizabeth McDermott**, b. Mar 1893 NY; m. **Edwin I. Spicher**. She graduated from the Allendale Grammar School 18 June 1908.
- **John Raymond McDermott**, b. June 1895 NY; d. 5 Mar 1919 Tours, France, while serving in World War I (he was a 2nd Lt., Salvage Sta. QMC, S. Pierre Dex C). He graduated from the Allendale Grammar School 23 June 1910.
